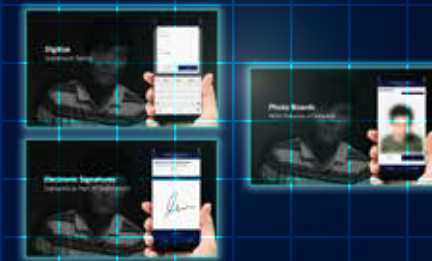

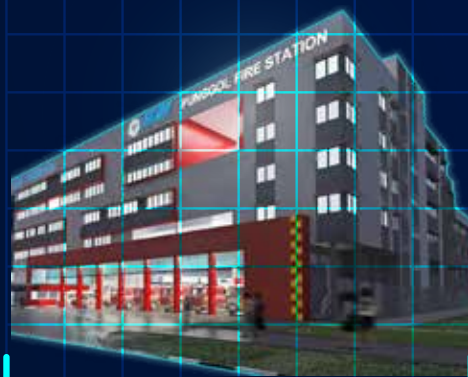

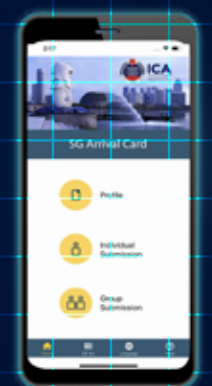

- Use analytics to detect, deter and solve crimes, and respond to incidents more effectively

### Augmenting frontline responders with drones and robotics



- Deploy robots and drones to complement ground operations

### Transforming to deliver better services for all



- Transform service delivery to the public with more convenient, tech-enabled service touchpoints and platforms

### Transforming workforce for the future



- Build competencies of Home Team officers to better exploit new technology
- Integrate technology to deliver training that is more effective and realistic

### Growing manpower needs



- Build core of science and tech experts to keep pace with changing technologies and evolving threats
- Grow Home Team's manpower and increase the number of Police investigators as cases have become more complex

## Keeping Singapore Safe in the Evolving Security Environment

### Safeguarding against terrorism



- Share intelligence and disrupt terrorist plots by working closely with foreign security agencies
- Encourage the public to report suspicious activities
- Constantly refine rehabilitation approach for detainees

### Safeguarding Singapore against foreign interference in domestic politics



- Review and enhance legal frameworks to safeguard Singapore against foreign interference and counter hostile information campaigns

### Strengthening protection from online harms



- Study experiences and regulatory models in other countries
- Review options such as introducing new legislation to deal with online harms effectively

Strengthening rehabilitation and  
reintegration of offenders



- Strengthen Preventive Drug Education (PDE) and outreach to combat liberal narratives on drugs
- Amend the Misuse of Drugs Act to enhance enforcement capabilities against New Psychoactive Substances (NPS)



- Partner the community to provide offenders with sustained throughcare support
- Enhance the capacity and capability of volunteers to better support inmates and ex-offenders
- Upgrade skills and enhance employability of ex-offenders

## Securing Singapore with the Community

### Partnering stakeholders to combat scams



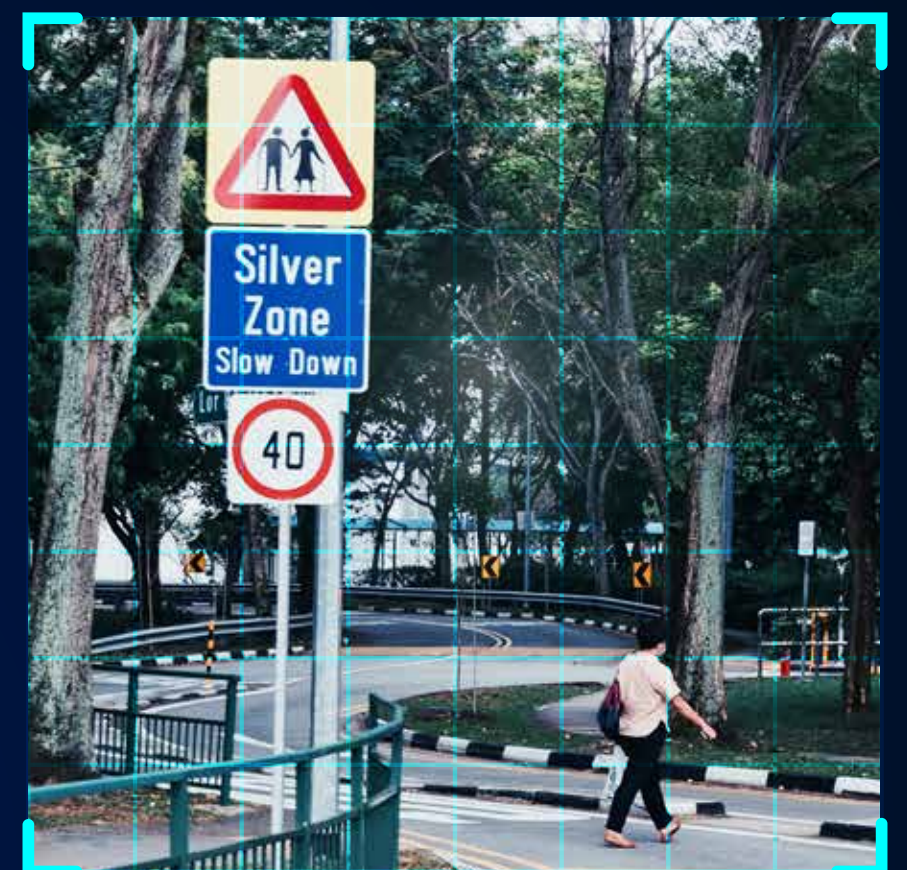
- Inter-Ministry Committee on Scams (IMCS) will deepen partnerships with community and private stakeholders such as banks, telcos and digital platforms, to raise awareness and strengthen defences against scams

### Reviewing key policies and legislation for private security agencies



- Develop the new Security Agencies Competency Evaluation (SACE) framework
- Amend the Private Security Industry Act to protect security officers against abuse when carrying out their duties

### Strengthening protection for vulnerable road users



- Introduce additional measures to better protect vulnerable road users such as elderly pedestrians and students, by increasing the penalties for motorists who commit offences at pedestrian crossings or offences that endanger pedestrian safety in Silver Zones and School Zones
