Fewer Scam Cases but Higher Losses Per Victim in 1H 2025

The median loss per case rose to \$1,500. Although the total amount lost to scams and the number of cases decreased in 1H2025, the scam situation remains of concern.

- 60.3% of scam victims were aged below 50, but the average amount lost per elderly victim was the highest among the various age groups.
- Phishing scams were most common. Government officials impersonation scam cases almost tripled. The amount lost to investment scams is the highest.
- Anti-Scam Command recovered more than \$56.7 million and averted at least \$179 million in potential losses. SPF will continue to work with government agencies to empower the public with knowledge, skills and tools to guard against scams.


Traffic Accidents Rise in 1H 2025, Continuing the Past Three Years' Upward Trend

Vulnerable road users continue to be over-represented in traffic fatalities and injuries. Police have stepped up enforcement, education and engagement.

- Red-light running accidents increased by 38.3%. The number of speeding violations increased by 45.5%.
- The number of accidents involving elderly pedestrians increased. Motorcyclists and pillion riders remained over-represented at 54.4% of all road deaths.
- Police ramping up safety measures, such as enhanced penalties for speeding offences from January 2026 and rolling out of new Traffic Violation Enforcement Cameras.
- Road safety is a shared responsibility. As road users, let us practise graciousness, good road safety habits and play our part in making Singapore's roads safer.
