Holistic Approaches Needed for Online Child Protection

Home Team Psychology Division (HTPD) and international experts discussed threats and prevention strategies at the 2025 ASEAN ICT Forum on Child Online Protection.



- Emerging digital threats to youths include hypersexualised content and divisive gender attitudes amplified by algorithms. Agencies should use early prevention strategies to address harmful sexual behaviours and gender-based violence.
- HTPD shared findings on youth harmful sexual behaviours and discussed prevention strategies including setting professional standards, community capability building and creative ways to engage youths. HTPD also facilitated a workshop to understand regional challenges in managing such behaviours.
- The upcoming ASEAN Regional Plan of Action for 2026-2030 will guide us and other member states towards more holistic online child protection, such as reducing pathways to offending and enhancing online safety measures.
