

TRAINING EXCELLENCE

Nine trainers and six training units from the various Home Team Departments received the Home Team Training Excellence Awards at a hybrid ceremony organised by HTA. ICA won the top two awards – the Home Team Trainer of the Year (Full-Time) and the Home Team Training Unit of the Year. ICA was also awarded **Special Commendation for Home Team Trainer of Year (Adjunct)**. SUPT Seah-Hong Pek Kuan, Head (Training & Learning) of ICA Training Command, shared that they were extremely humbled by the win. "We were trying various new methods to enhance training for our learners during COVID-19," she said. "This win is a confidence boost for us as it affirms that we're moving in the right direction, and we hope to continue to do so by exploring different types of training pedagogies."



In her speech to award recipients, 2MIN Josephine Teo said she was heartened by the Home Team's efforts to develop officers through initiatives like SCDF's Training & Learning Enterprise System (which allows users to track their learning progress over the course of their careers) and the Civilian Milestone Programmes from HTA's Home Team Civilian Training School. BREAKING THE CYCLE OF FAMILY VIOLENCE

MOS Muhammad Faishal Ibrahim attend the "End the Cycle of Abuse: Our Children's Journey" symposium organised by Casa Raudha. MOS Faishal noted ongoing efforts by the Government to support children and families experiencing abuse. Symposium participants also learnt more about the long-term impact of child abuse and how the community can work together to encourage perpetrators to seek help.

DID YOU KNOW? In September, the multi-stakeholder Taskforce on Family Violence released its report with 16 recommendations to tackle family violence in Singapore. Chaired by MOS Muhammad Faishal Ibrahim and MOS/MSF Sun Xueling, the Taskforce comprised 21 members from various government agencies and social service agencies (including Casa Raudha Ltd).

ENGINEERING TO SAVE LIVES



SCDF received the Prestigious Engineering Achievement Award from the Institution of Engineers, Singapore. The Award recognises individuals or organisations behind engineering projects that have made significant contribution to the engineering progress and quality of life in Singapore, such as by improving the well-being of people and communities, or by showcasing resourcefulness and planning in designing solutions.





SCDF received the Prestigious Engineering Achievement Award for its Responders' Performance Vehicle (RPV), a pioneering mobile facility that leverages medical science, technology and engineering to provide on-site treatment to SCDF emergency responders. During prolonged operations, the RPV ensures high levels of operational performance by emergency responders and increases safety by reducing the chance of heat injuries. Congratulations, Lifesavers!

DID YOU KNOW? The RPV was developed by SCDF in collaboration with medical doctors who are SCDF Operationally Ready National Servicemen, academics and local engineering firm HOPE Technik.

MAKING A POSITIVE IMPACT WHILE SERVING THEIR SENTENCES



The National Youth Achievement Award 2021 Ceremony was held on 17 November at the Prison School and concurrently at Cluster A and B to comply strictly with safe management measures. There were 33 Gold, 32 Silver and 17 Bronze awards given to the inmate participants.

This year's theme was "STEP Up to Reach Out," which highlighted the accomplishments of participants' in four areas: Service to Community; To Aspire and Dream; Excel through Learning; and Pave Your Own Path.



Minister for Education Mr Chan Chun Sing commended the efforts of inmate participants in demonstrating their resilience and completing the National Youth Achievement Award programme, as well as the dedication of SPS in providing opportunities for inmate participants to make a positive impact while serving their sentences.
